



Gloop:

You require:

- ✎ 2 cups of cornflour.
- ✎ 1 cup of cold water.

Pour the cornflour into a bowl.

Slowly add the cold water, stirring constantly.

Stop when the water is barely absorbed by the cornflour.

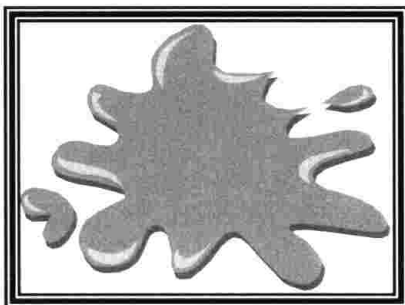
Finger Paint:

You require:

- ✎ 2 cups of cornflour.
- ✎ 1 cup of cold water.
- ✎ 4-5 cups of boiling water.
- ✎ ¼ cup of soap flakes (optional).

Mix together the cornflour and the cold water.

Add 4–5 cups of boiling water to the cornflour, then beat until the mixture “grabs”. Stir thoroughly until the mixture is smooth, thick and translucent. Add ¼ cup soap flakes if desired and keep stirring. Colour can be added by using a small amount of food colouring.



Magic Mud:

You require:

- ✎ 2 cups of cornflour.
- ✎ Approximately 1 cup of cold water.
- ✎ Food colouring.

Mix together for Magic Mud to play with!

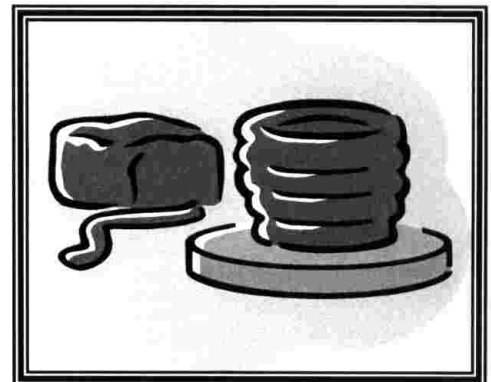
Clay:

You require:

- ✎ 225 grams of cornflour.
- ✎ 350 grams of baking soda.
- ✎ 360 mls of hot water.

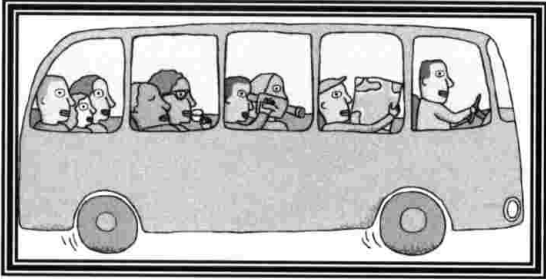
Mix together cornflour and baking soda in a large pot. Add water all at once and cook until thickened and smooth.

Turn onto a cool, heatproof surface and cover with a damp cloth. Once the dough has cooled, knead it with your hands until it is smooth and pliable. This dough is great for making models and decorations.
